## K5-12 TUITION AND FEES 2018-2019

### APPLICATION/RE-ENROLLMENT FEE

- This fee is **required** with the application/re-enrollment for every new and returning student. Payment covers application processing and temporarily reserves a classroom space until the Admissions Committee grants final acceptance.

### MATRICULATION FEE 2018-2019

- CCS does not grant full acceptance to any student until the matriculation fee is paid.

### GENERAL INFORMATION

#### Payments

Student tuition is billed to parents in ten statements. Statements are emailed around the 20th and payments are **DUE ON THE FIFTH (5<sup>th</sup>)**. The first tuition payment is due August 5, and the last tuition payment is due May 5. Matriculation is billed at the end of May.

### Late Fee

CCS adds a **\$25 late fee** for payments received after the **fifteenth (15<sup>th</sup>) of the month** and a **\$100 late fee** for accounts **thirty days past due**. Please call the Finance Office if your payment will be late.

### Lunch Accounts

With parental permission, students may order lunches in homeroom. Full details of these purchases are included on the monthly bill. Lunch prices are \$3.50 (K-6) and \$3.75 (7-12). Beverages (white milk, chocolate milk, juice, water) in addition to or separate from lunch trays are \$0.50 each.

### School Care for K5-12 Grade Students

All students who are still present at 3:30pm must report to after school care. CCS bills students for school care on a monthly basis.

- 7:30 – 8:10 a.m. No charge during the morning session
- 3:30 – 4:30 p.m. or any portion thereof \$3.00 per student
- 4:30 – 5:30 p.m. or any portion after 4:30pm \$3.00 per student

**Please note that after school care ends at 5:30 p.m.** Families whose students are not picked up by 5:30 p.m. will be charged a \$10 late pick-up fee AND an additional \$1 for each additional minute thereafter. School care is not available when school is not in session.

### Withdrawal

In the event a student is withdrawn from CCS, all fees are nonrefundable. CCS will refund the monthly tuition payment for the month in which a student is withdrawn if the withdrawal takes place by the fifteenth (15<sup>th</sup>). Withdrawal after the fifteenth (15<sup>th</sup>) requires full payment of that month's tuition.

## OTHER FEES AS APPLICABLE

**Technology Fee** - \$30 per student/per semester (billed Aug. 1 and Jan. 1); designated toward Google Chromebook purchases (in-school usage only), student software upgrades, and all other student-related technology expenses.

**Placement Testing** - New and transfer students may be required to take an online placement test. Payment of \$30 is due at testing time.

**Credit Recovery Fee** - Credit recovery costs are the full responsibility of the parent or guardian, whether for courses a student failed or courses that did not transfer from a previous school (minimum C required). Credit recovery methods vary depending on the student's schedule and course availability. CCS must approve all credit recovery courses prior to a student's registration for any credit recovery course. Students whose schedules are out of sync or who need to recover a missing credit required for graduation will be billed a \$295 per-semester fee for each credit recovery course taken during the school year.

**PE Uniforms** - The following PE uniform is required for all students in grades 5-8 for gym class:

- CCS PE Shirt – available for \$10 from the school. PE shirts from previous years may be worn as long as they are still in good condition.
- CCS PE Shorts – available for \$15 from the school. Students may wear only CCS-issued shorts. No other shorts are permitted. Students may also opt to wear navy warm-up pants as desired.

**Athletic Participation Fee** - Students in grades 7-12 involved in team sports (soccer, volleyball, basketball, cheerleading) will be charged a \$75 participation fee per activity. Students participating on varsity girls' and boys' varsity basketball teams will also be charged a one-time \$50 off-site gym rental fee.

**Graduation** - CCS bills students for the following graduation fees in April:

- Kindergarten \$25 per student
- High School \$40 per student

**Yearbook** - Each student in grades 7-12 will receive a yearbook. In addition, the oldest elementary child per family (grades K5-6<sup>th</sup>) will also receive a yearbook. Families may order additional yearbooks as desired. Further details on pricing will be available during the school year.

**Math Pioneers Program** - Each student participating in Math Pioneers, a specialized program for high-ability math students in grades 2-6, will be billed \$100 per semester (billed in September and February).

**Colonial Assessment Prep (CAP)** - Students in grade 4-12 participating in CAP, a program to help students better prepare for ILEARN and ISTEP+ as well as College Career Readiness exams (ACT / SAT), will be billed \$30 per year with a family maximum of \$50 per year billed in October.

**Robotics Club** - Each student in grades 4-6 participating in the Robotics Club will be billed \$25 per year.

**Private Tutoring** - Private tutoring by a qualified teacher is available for students who will benefit from 1-on-1 instruction. The rate is \$15 per half hour.

**Instrument Rental Fee** - A limited number of band instruments are available for \$75 per semester. Priority is given to beginning students with documented financial need.

**Music Lessons** - Families may enroll their student(s) in private lessons for an additional fee through the Indianapolis Academy of Fine Arts ([www.iafaindy.org](http://www.iafaindy.org)). Family agrees by written contract to pay for all nine months of lessons until the contract expires.
